PROCEDURAL MATTERS

Heard together with case 9. SWE-221 vs FIN-1008

FACTS FOUND

Boats approaching mark 5 on Reach and on Port tack to round the mark.

SWE-221 inside windward, FIN-1008 outside leeward overlapped . RUS-313 clear astern, when entering the zone.

While rounding overlap between SWE-221 and FIN-1008 was broken. FIN-1008 was luffing to sail on windward side of SWE-221.

RUS-313 established inside windward overlap with FIN-1008 on collision course. FIN-1008 bored down to avoid RUS-313.

There was a contact between bow of FIN-1008 and starboard corner of SWE-221. Gelcoat damage occurred on starboard stern corner of SWE-221.

The damage did not affect further racing of SWE-221.

No penalty taken.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. FIN-1008 as clear astern failed to keep clear of SWE-221 clear ahead, as required by RRS 12.
- 2. Although it was reasonably possible FIN-1008 did not avoid contact with SWE-221 as required by RRS 14.
- 3. RUS-313, clear astern at the time FIN-1008 reached the zone, failed to give FIN-1008 mark-room, as required by RRS 18.2(b).

DECISION

RUS-313 is scored DSQ in race 10. FIN-1008 is scored DSQ in Race 10.
