PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. The wind was 10 Kts, flat water.
- 2. GER 213282 and CZE 208693 were sailing on starboard tack close hauled to mark 1.
- 3. They were overlapped with the full boatlength in a distance of 1/2 boatlenght and CZE 208693 to leeward.
- 4. In a distance of 2 boatlengths to the mark CZE 208693 tacked to port.
- 5. There was contact between the bow of CZE 208693 and the port side midships of GER 213282.
- 6. There was damage on GER 213282. The gelcoat is of the deck is gone off.
- 7. CZE 208693 was aware that he broke a rule.
- No boat took a penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. CZE 208693 on port failed to keep clear of GER 213282 on starboard, as required by RRS 10
- 2. Although it was reasonably possible CZE 208693 did not avoid contact with GER 213282 as required by RRS 14.
- 3. It was not reasonably possible for GER 213282, the right-of-way boat, to avoid contact with CZE 208693 when it was clear that CZE 208693 was not keeping clear.
- 4. By knowingly breaking a rule and not taking the appropriate penalty, CZE 208693 failed to compete in compliance with the principles of sportsmanship and fair play, as required by RRS 2
