#### PROCEDURAL MATTERS

#### FACTS FOUND

- 1. On the first windward leg of Race 8, during 1/3 to 1/2 way up the leg, the wind speed was averaging about 8 knots and the sea-state was choppy.
- 2. AUS 1130 was on starboard and AUS 1360 on port were sailing on a close-hauled converging course.
- 3. At 2 boat lengths apart, AUS 1130 bore away slightly.
- 4. At less than 1 boat lengths apart, AUS 1130 bore away sharply on a course to pass astern of AUS 1360.
- 5. AUS 1360 bore away slightly to avoid contact.
- 6. The closest distance between the two boats was 1m.
- 7. If neither boats changed course, AUS 1130's bow would have contacted AUS 1360's starboard side just aft of amidships.
- 8. No contact and no penalty were taken.

#### CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

AUS 1360 on port failed to keep clear of AUS 1130 on starboard, and broke RRS 10.
