# **PROCEDURAL MATTERS**

### **FACTS FOUND**

- 1. Tom Allard notified the parties of a possible conflict of interest. The parties agreed to proceed.
- 2. On the first downwind leg in about 20 knots of breeze.
- 3. Arbitrage jibed to port and luffed to pass astern of Ne\*Ne
- 4. Arbitrage crossed close to the transom of Ne\*Ne, and then bore down
- 5. Within 2 boatlengths of Arbitrage, Ne\*Ne also on port luffed.
- 6. Arbitrage luffed abruptly.
- 7. Ne\*Ne luffed continuously.
- 8. The boom of Arbitrage hit the stanchions of Ne\*Ne
- 9. The stanchion of Ne\*Ne was damaged.

### **CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY**

- 1. Arbitrage to windward failed to keep clear of Ne\*Ne to leeward, as required by RRS 11.
- 2. Although it was reasonably possible, Ne\*Ne, the right-of-way boat, did not avoid contact with Arbitrage when it was clear that Arbitrage was not keeping clear, as required by RRS 14

3. The collision caused damage.
