Jury will follow standard World Sailing Jury policy. In addition Jury is publishing following:

## Penalty Bands and Base Penalty Bands for Specific Breaches

- 1) Penalties are divided into 4 bands with the mid point being the normal base penalty:
- (a) Band 1 0 10% (mid point 5%)
- (b) Band 2 10 30% (mid point 20%)
- (c) Band 3 30 70% (mid point 50%)
- (d) Band 4 DSQ / DNE (starting point DSQ)

2) Generally the base penalty will be the mid-point of the band.
