- 1. Register first and receive Account Login details
- 2. Online payment (or at DOSC reception). Closing date 17<sup>th</sup> February 2024
- 3. Part 1: Upload documents for Skipper and Boat (contacts, boat detail, photo, license, IRC cert, insurance, crew list, proof of payment)
- 4. <u>Part 2:</u> Crew Registration (upload personal details, passport, visa). Deadline of Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2024

### Races & Race Course

#### **Main Race**

- 360 miles from Dubai to Muscat within 5 days
- Escorted to Khasab by UAE Coastguard
- Escorted from Khasab by Oman Navy and RoP
- Same finish line. Virtual timing gates introduced

#### Sprint to the Corner

Finish line at the Gap (and projected)

#### **Restart Race**

- If retired at the corner, restart on Monday morning for the 'indefatigable' prize
- We want boats to make it to Muscat

#### Return Passage/Race

- Stopover in Fujairah (FIMC)
- Muscat to Khasab race (OTC 3)



## **Security Update**

### Lt Cdr Dougie Bell RN, OiC UKMTO British Embassy, Dubai

UKMTO send their apologies, will attend in January, and have the following current advice:

- Generally little change to previous advice
- Marine drones the same, but little chance of seeing them north of Muscat
- Significant attempted seizure incident by 'Iran' 14nm off Muscat in July
- Be aware of increased tension from Israel/Gaza situation
- Significant illicit smuggling activity out of Khasab

## **Destination in Muscat**



- Approach can be from any direction
- Watch out for islands
- Watch out for large vessels
- Watch out for pots and nets
- Be prepared for light, fickle winds and a wait

### Finish Line – Outside the Island

### **Oman Immigration**

- Oman E-Visa is required prior to race start
- Immigration will take passports away to Port Sultan Qaboos for 6-12 hours
  - Can stamp 'in' or 'in&out' for immediate departure
  - Can stamp out in later process
- You CANNOT stop&go without stamping passport
- Customs may inspect boat
- MBaR Redevelopment in April 2023



## **Arrival Back in Dubai**

When arriving back in Dubai, boats <u>MUST</u> dock first at Port Rashid marina who will escort you to the cruise liner terminal outside Mina Rashid for passport immigration




## What About the Weather?

### **Expect Anything & Everything**

5-15kts is the 'normal'

plus: calms, 40 kts, water spouts, huge lightening, torrential rain, cold at night, big tides, large confused waves

Engine seawater pump failure & jellyfish blockage	Ran out of water bottles and water tank leak / rationing	Instrument failure (compass light)	Windows/top hatches open in rough weather

Cracked engine sump	Mast track failure	Katabatic/Anabatic wind surprise	Navigation light failure
