FACTS FOUND

- 1. Wind was 18 to 20 knots and the sea was choppy.
- 2. On a beat to windward, GER 1457 was sailing on on starboard tack and DEN 8 was sailing on on port tack
- 3. Both boats were on converging courses.
- 4. At 1,5 boat length from DEN 586, GER 1457 started tacking onto port and finished his tack 1 m to leeward of GER 1457
- 5. Hadn't GER 1457 tacked, there would have been a collision between GER 1457's bow and the starboard side of DEN 586, 3 m from the stern.

DEN 586, on port tack failed to keep clear of GER 1457 on starboard tack, and broke RRS 10. Application of case 50
