1. DATE & VENUE

The **KEDAH OPEN YOUTH SAILING CHAMPIONSHIP 2022** will be held from 16-19 June 2022 at *the National Sailing Centre, Langkawi, Kedah, Malaysia.*

2. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The regatta is organized by Kedah Sailing Association and Kedah Sport Council (MSNK) under auspices of Malaysian Sailing Association (MSA)

3. ENTRY

The regatta will be open to both national (Malaysian) and international participants.

4. CLASSES

- (i) ILCA 7 (under 19) Born on 2003 and after
- (ii) ILCA 6 Men / Women (Under 19) Born on 2003 and after
- (iii) ILCA 4 (Under 17) Boys & Girls Born on 2005 and after
- (iv) Optimist (under 16) Born on 2007 and after (included Optimist Team Race)
- (v) International 420 Open (Under 19) Born on 2003 and after
- (vi) Windsurfing RS-One (Under 19) Girls & Boys Born on 2003 and after
- (vii) Windsurfing Bic Techno (under 17) Boys & Girls Born on 2005 and after

**(Provided there is a minimum of 5 entries in each category if the class less than 5 entries will mix boys and girls)*

5. RULES

- 5.1 The regatta will be governed by RRS 2021- 2024 World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the Class Rules, the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions
- 5.2 National prescriptions if any will apply.
- 5.3 In all rules governing this event, the notations;
 - 5.3.1 [DP] in a rule means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.
 - 5.3.2 [SP] denotes a rule for which a standard penalty may be applied by the race committee without a hearing or a discretionary penalty applied by the protest committee with a hearing. This changes RRS 63.1 and A5.
 - 5.3.3 [NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. These changes RRS 60.1(a)
- 5.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 5.5 The Equipment Rules of Sailing will apply.

6 EVENT ADVERTISING

- 6.1 Competitor advertising will be restricted to World Sailing Regulation 20, Advertising Code.
- 6.2 [DP] Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

7 MEASUREMENTS

- 7.1 Except for boats that are supplied by the organizing authority, each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.
- 7.2 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless approved in writing by the technical committee. Requests for substitution shall be made to the technical committee at the first reasonable opportunity by filling in a relevant form at the Race Office. The substitution may only be permitted after the technical committee has checked and scrutinized both the damaged and the substituting equipment.
- 7.3 If the substitution was made on the water before or between races, both the damaged and the equipment substituted shall be presented to the technical committee after the end of the day's racing. Repairs or replacements required afloat may be approved after the race provided that either the race committee or the technical committee afloat is notified before the next race.
- 7.4 Once a boat has completed measurements, the hull may not be removed from the boat park without the permission of the race committee.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 8.1 RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures for RRS 42, will apply

9. JURY

International Jury will be appointed by the organizer and will act accordance with RRS 70.5 and appendixes N. Decision of juries are final and not subject to appeal

10. [DP] SUPPORT VESSELS

Team support vessels shall be registered with the Organising Authority and used according to the following condition

- 10.1 Support vessels shall clearly display a flag with their State club or country name or shall be permanently marked with a sticker with their State, club or country name, clearly visible from both sides of the vessel or engine. The minimum height for the letters shall be 200mm. No other flags or identification shall be displayed by support vessels.
- 10.2 Fuel and other consumables shall be paid by the teams using the vessel.
- 10.3 Personnel on board support vessels are required to wear a life jacket or personal floatation device whilst on the water and to be a certified power boat certificate holder from MSA or from the own country.
- 10.4 **All Coaches, managers and Team support personal must register.**

11. ENTRIES & FEES

Entrance fees are **USD80.00/per participant for Optimist Class** and **USD100.00/per participant for other classes** registered before 20 May 2022. Late register after 1 June 2022 Entry Fees will be USD100.00/Per participant for Optimist class and USD120.00/Per participant for other classes. All local sailors (Malaysian) Entrance fees are **RM120.00/per participant for Optimist Class** and **RM150.00/per participant for other classes**

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21. Single use water bottles and pack food in plastic container

- 21.1 All competitors and officials are request to bring own Water bottles and Plastic food container. A 'single Use' plastic Bottles, plastic food container any plastic to the venue and racing area on Water is not advisable.
- 21.2 The event organizer will not provide any water containers
- 21.3 Water will be available at the venue from water dispensers.

22. COVID 19 MITIGATION REQUIREMENT

- 22.1 All Participants, team leaders, coaches and support staff shall adhere to the event COVID 19 Protocol as Publish.
- 22.2 The Venue will be Close to the general public. All participants, team leaders, coaches *And support staff must register with the Organizing Authority to obtain accreditation to access the Venue.*
- 22.3 *To Obtain Accreditation a person from oversea and outside Langkawi must present a Negative Covid19 PCR test result no older than 72 hours.*
- 22.4 *Accreditation to enter the venue may be revoked by the Organizing Authority if a Person is found breaching the following requirement:*
 - (a) *Persons attending the event shall be screened for body temperature and register and screen My Sejahtera before entering the venue.*

- (b) Persons attending the event shall observe a physical distance to others at least 1 meter.*
- (c) Persons attending the event shall wear a properly fitted suitable face mask while ashore at the venue.*
- (d) Persons attending the event shall use hand sanitizer before entering the venue and before entering the race offices, the Changing rooms and any others office buildings.*
- (e) Persons attending the event shall be required to submit to a Covid 19 PCR Swab Test when requested to do so by the OA.*

- 22.5 Persons who display suspected symptoms as determined by an doctor appointed by the OA against the Event COVID19 Protocol or who test positive for Covid 19 may be excluded from accessing the venue and shall be reported to the local health authorities.*
- 22.6 It is the responsibility of the participant to report any suspected symptoms, commit To self-isolation, and follow the instructions of the local health authorities until a Covid 19 PCR swab test produces a negative result.*
