PROCEDURAL MATTERS

- 1. Hearing No. 5 was heard together with Hearing No. 6 in accordance with RRS 63.2 since both hearings arose from the same incident.
- 2. POL 280 was represented by Marcelina KORSZON.
- 3. GER 682 was represented by Leander BAUMANN.
- HUN 248 was represented by Vince ERDI.
- 5. Sarolta KORBULY (HUN 248's crew) attended the hearing as interpreter for HUN 248.
- 6. GER 252 (witness) was represented by Johann SACH.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Conditions: light wind, flat water.
- 2. Approaching mark 1, POL 280 was on starboard, above the starboard layline.
- 3. GER 682 was on port, on a converging course.
- 4. HUN 248 was on port, overlapped 5m to windward of GER 682, with GER 682 bow forward.
- 5. GER 682 hailed twice HUN 248 for room to tack.
- 6. Five seconds later, HUN 248 tacked onto the starboard layline.
- 7. Immediately after, GER 682 luffed and passed head to wind in the zone.
- 8. Before GER 682 reached a close-hauled course, POL 280 luffed and her jib flapped.
- 9. If POL 280 had not luffed, there would have been a contact between POL 280's bow and the back of GER 682's starboard wing.
- 10. The minimum distance between POL 280 and GER 682 during the incident was less than 1m.
- 11. None of the boat took a penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 13, 18.3, 20.2(b), 20.2(c), 43.1(b), 63.2

- HUN 248 failed to tack as soon as possible after GER 682 hailed her for room to tack, as required by RRS 20.2(b) and (c).
- 2. After passing head to wind and before being on a close-hauled course, GER 682 failed to keep clear of POL 280. GER 682 broke RRS 13.
- 3. After GER 682 passed head to wind from port to starboard tack inside the zone and was then fetching the mark, she

- caused POL 280 on starboard tack since entering the zone, to sail above close-hauled to avoid contact. GER 682 broke RRS 18.3.
- 4. Since GER 682 broke RRS 13 and 18.3 while she was sailing within the room to which she was entitled, she is exonerated under RRS 43.1(b) for this breach.
