PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

1. During final race 2, with wind over 10 knots and gusty, on the second downwind leg, GBR 2347 was sailing on starboard on a collision course with GER 1384 sailing on port
2. At two boat lengths from GER 1384, when it became clear to GBR 2347 that GER 1384 would not keep clear, GBR 2347 gybed to port
3. There was a collision between the bowsprit of GER 1384 and the main sail of GBR 2347, with damage to the main sail of GBR 2347.
4. As a result of the collision GBR 2347 capsized.
4. The mainsail of GBR 2347 was ripped off the mast and below the lower batten.
5. After recovering from capsize GBR finished race 2 and could not sail race 3.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

GER 1384 failed to keep clear of GBR 2347 and broke RRS 10

GER 1384 did not avoid the collision and broke RRS 14.

It was not reasonably possible for GBR 2347 to avoid the collision and she did not break rule 14.

The score of GBR 2347 was made significantly worse in race 3 of the final series by no fault of her own as a result of the breach of GER 1384 of a rule of part 2.

Protest Upheld

GER 1384 is to be scored DSQ in race 2.
GBR 2347 is granted redress in race 3 of the final series based on average of races 1 and 2 of the final series.
