The RC claims W145 and W122 failed to round M1 the 2nd time in Race 2  $\,$ 

#### **PROCEDURAL MATTERS**

Both W145 and W122 appeared together. Tracker evidence was allowed in the hearing.

#### FACTS FOUND

- 1. In Race 2 of the Raceboard Class, W2 course was signaled.
- 2. There was a Mark Vessel stationed at  $\ensuremath{\texttt{M1}}$
- 3. W145 and W122 were recorded as not rounding M1 the 2nd time as required in Course W2
- 4. Both W145 and W122 carried GPS trackers when racing in Race 2
- 5. The tracker record for R2 clearly showed W145 and W122 rounding M1 correctly the 2nd time in Race 2.
