FACTS FOUND

- 1. After closing the hearing for Protests 08 and 09, the Protest Committee reviewed Case 92, Case 93 and US Appeal 108.
- 2. The Protest Committee failed to consider Rule 16 in its previous decision on Protests 08 and 09.
- 3. The Protest Committee was comprised of the judges that heard the original hearing per RRS 66.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. The protest committee made a significant error in not considering RRS 16.1 in the decisions for protests 08 and 09 and reopened the hearing per RRS 66.
- 2. In continuously changing her course, Ne*Ne the right-of-way boat, failed to give Arbitrage, room to keep clear, in a seamanlike way as required by RRS 16.1. (Case 92, Case 93, US Appeal 108)
- 3. Arbitrage was compelled to break RRS 11 by the actions of Ne * Ne and is exonerated under RRS 64.1.
