April 6-7

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by *The Racing Rules of Sailing,* Appendix V, and the local fleet rules for each of the one design classes.
- 1.2 All competitors shall wear a PFD while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing, or below deck. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This changes RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4.
- 1.3 US Sailing Prescriptions 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the J/120, J/105, J/88, J/70, and J/24 classes. Other one design classes are invited to contact the StFYC Race Office by 3/23/19 for possible inclusion in the regatta. Classes must have a minimum of six (6) boats registered before 4/3/19 to qualify for a start.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form and paying the entry fee online www.stfyc.com, on or before 4/2/19 to avoid late fee penalties.
- 2.3 All entry fees are non-refundable on or after 4/3/18.
