



RULES TO CONTRAST AND CONTAIN OF THE DIFFUSION OF COVID-19 DURING FRAGLIA VELA MALCESINE REGATTAS

(following the provisions relating to the contrast and containment of covid 19 issued by the italian federation - protocol regulating the measures for the contrast and containment of the dissemination of covid-19 in the affiliated companies and sports associations of 14 July)

1. REGATTA REGISTRATION

Regattas registration processes shall be completely online, on the following website: <http://fragliavela.sailti.com/en/default/races> by the date established by the notice of race.

Payment must be made exclusively by bank transfer or Paypal. Payments by debit card, credit card or cash at the Race Office are NOT accepted.

All the documentations required for regatta registrations (e.g. insurance policy, tonnage certificate, payment receipt, etc.) shall be sent by the terms established by the notice of race by email at race@fragliavela.org.

Before the start of the event, competitors must provide a self-certification stating that their body temperature is below 37.5° (form available at http://fragliavela.sailti.com/uploaded_files/Document_22641_20200704114243_en.pdf).

The registration is completed with the payment and the required documentation send. It is not necessary to go to the race office to sign the disclaimer form / accept privacy information.

All the support staff and in particular coaches or accompanying persons must register on the regatta website <http://fragliavela.sailti.com/en/default/races>. To complete the accreditation procedure, coaches shall go to the race office to collect the "S" recognition flag (€ 20 deposit). The distribution of the "S" flags (and of any regatta gadgets) takes place outside the race office, on the lake side (see point A on the Map).

2. RULES ASHORE AT THE CLUB

Participation in the event is limited to competitors, instructors / coaches or support person and other technical staff only.

Every day, all participants shall independently measure and record body temperature using Annex 3 (form available at <http://fragliavela.sailti.com/en/default/races>) which must be delivered at the club entrance.

Inside the club it is mandatory to **always wear the mask to cover the nose and mouth** and to maintain, where possible, the distance of at least 1 meter from another person.

Use of toilets: it is mandatory to respect the maximum capacity indicated outside the rooms (3 people in the female changing rooms and 5 people in the male changing rooms). It is allowed to

use the changing rooms and bags, clothing, shoes, etc. cannot be deposited, as they would not allow a correct and periodic cleaning and sanitization of the rooms themselves.

During briefings it is necessary to keep a distance of one meter and the use of the mask is mandatory. Only one representative per boat it is allowed to participate in the briefing. In youth classes regattas, only one coach per team is allowed.

For any race office activities in attendance, respect the social distance of 1 meter with the staff in charge and equipped with a mask.

The Notice Board is exclusively online on the regatta website: <http://fragliavela.sailti.com/en/default/races> or on <https://www.racingrulesofsailing.org/> where all the official announcements and rankings will be posted.

Any forms needed to return after the races (protest form, competitors declarations, scoring inquiring) are available on the regatta website <http://fragliavela.sailti.com/en/default/races> and must be sent filled in at race@fragliavela.org or on <https://www.racingrulesofsailing.org/> If it is not possible to use online devices at the end of races, the forms will be available outside the race office, on the lake side (see point A on the Map below).

3. BEHAVIOR TO KEEP IN WATER DURING RACES

Competitors on monotype boats when not engaged in regatta must use face masks.

It is compulsory for coaches / instructors and any other support staff to have personal protective equipment on board the inflatable boats (stored in dry spaces or waterproof bags to ensure effective use) to be used in the event of impossibility of respecting interpersonal distance.

4. SOCIAL EVENTS

During the prize-giving it is mandatory to keep the interpersonal distance of at least 1 meter.

Climbing onto the podium is allowed for a maximum of 2 crew members. Competitors on the podium shall use face masks except for photos.

GOOD HYGIENE PRACTICES TO MAINTAIN

- Wash your hands frequently;
- Never touch your eyes, nose and mouth with your hands;
- Sneezing and / or coughing in a tissue avoiding contact of the hands with respiratory secretions; if you do not have a handkerchief available, sneeze into the inner fold of the elbow;
- Avoid leaving personal worn clothing in places shared with others, but store them in personal backpacks or bags and, once you have returned home, wash them separately from other clothing;
- Always drink from disposable glasses or personalized bottles;
- Immediately dispose of paper tissues or other used materials such as plasters, bandages, etc. in suitable containers.
