PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

1. POL 31 and USA 59 were approaching mark 1 on starboard, POL 31 clear ahead of USA 59

- 2. POL 31 bore away to round the mark and there was contact between the kites
- 3. POL 31 capsized.

4. USA 59 sailed on and finished the race

- 5. POL 31 recovered and sailed to the finish line, arriving after the finish window has over
- 6. There was no damage or injury and no boat took a penalty

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

1. USA 59 entering the zone clear astern, did not give mark room to POL 31, entering the zone clear aster, breaking rule 18.2(a)(1)

2. POL 31, entitled to mark room, changed course and the position of her kite without giving room to USA 59 to keep clear breaking rule 16.1 but is exonerated under rule 21

3. The score of POL 31 was not made significantly worse through no fault of their own by a tangle, damage or injury caused by the action of a kiteboard that was breaking a rule of part 2, therefore POL 31 is not entitled to redress
