



# 2019 Open Dutch Sailing Championships Notice of Race

#### **Open Dutch Championship for the following classes:**

Laser Standard, Laser Standard U21(born in 1999 or later), Laser Radial (Men and Women), Finn, Contender, 29er, 49er, 49erFX(open), Nacra15, F18, Dart 18, J22, SB20, Yngling and Star.

#### Class event for:

Laser 4.7

Friday 20, Saturday 21 and Sunday 22, September 2019 (for F18 class: Saturday 21 and Sunday 22 September 2019)

## Organizing authority: The Royal Netherlands Yachting Union (RNYU) in conjunction with RYC Hollandia and Sportivents.

[DP] denotes a rule for which the penalty is at the discretion of the Jury

#### 1 RULES

- **1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the RNYU will apply. (see <a href="http://www.sailing.org/41717.php">http://www.sailing.org/41717.php</a>)
- **1.3** The 'Rules for Championships Sailing, Windsurfing and Kiteboarding' will apply.
- **1.4** The Sailing Instructions may contain changes to the rules.
- **1.5** If there is a conflict between languages the English language will take precedence.
- **1.6** Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.
- 1.7 [DP] Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. This changes RRS 40.
- 1.8 For SB20 only: The following rule will be changed in accordance with RRS 86.1(b) and 90.2(c): The Race Committee will use VHF radio for communication. Failure to make broadcasts or failure to hear the broadcast shall not constitute grounds for granting redress. This changes RRS 62.1. The Sailing Instructions will provide more details on the procedure.
- **1.9** For Nacra15 only: The Race Committee may make the use of a helmet (EN1385 standard) mandatory.

#### 2 [DP] ADVERTISING

- Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.
- **2.2** Competitors may be required to carry on-board cameras, sound equipment and positioning equipment on their boats.

#### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the above mentioned classes.

  Competitors in the Laser Standard or Laser Radial who reach the ages of 35 or competitors in de Finn who reach the ages of 40 during 2019 will compete also in the Masters.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by registration with the organizing authority at the website <a href="https://www.opendutchsailing.org">www.opendutchsailing.org</a>. The registration will be open Monday July 1st 2019. The entry is only completed once payment of complete entry fee has been received and the Parent/Guardian Consent and Declaration Form are accepted.







3.3 Competitors can request a cancellation of their entry by sending the OA an email to info@opendutchsailing.nl In case such request is made before Thursday September 12<sup>th</sup> 2019 2400 (local time) and is accepted by the OA, the entry fee will be reimbursed after deduction of an administrative fee of €15.00. After Thursday September 12<sup>th</sup> 2019 no refunds will be given.

#### 4 FEES

**4.1** Fees are stated in Euro and include any local taxes. Entries including payment received before Monday September 2<sup>nd</sup> 2019 2400 (local time) will qualify for the Early Entry fee.

The entry fee is also payable at registration, (only cash, no credit cards or pin).

#### 5 SCHEDULE OF RACES AND EVENTS

**5.1** The race office will be open for registration on Thursday September 19<sup>th</sup> from 1700 till 2100 and on racing days from 0800 on.

Crew weighing for J22 and SB20 class will take place on Thursday September  $19^{th}$  from 1800 till 2100 and on Friday September  $20^{th}$  from 0800 till 1000.

Crew weighing for F18 class will take place on Friday September 20<sup>th</sup> from 1900 till 2000 and on Saturday September 21<sup>st</sup> from 0800 till 1000.

- **5.3** The following classes will race together in one fleet:
  - Finn class: Finn and Finn Master class
  - Laser Standard class: Laser Standard, Laser Standard U21 and Laser Standard
     Masters
  - Laser Radial class: Laser Radial Men, Laser Radial Women and Laser Radial Masters
- On Friday September 6<sup>th</sup>, 2019 the Draft Schedule of Races will be published at the web site <a href="www.opendutchsailing.org">www.opendutchsailing.org</a>. On Friday September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2019 no first warning signal will be made before 1000 (Saturday September 21<sup>st</sup> for F18).
- **5.5** No warning signal will be made after 1600 on the last day of the regatta.
- **5.6** A meeting for all class representatives is scheduled for 1930 on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> upstairs in the Regatta Office.

#### **6 MEASUREMENT**

- **6.1** For classes where the Class Rules require a valid measurement certificate for racing, measurement certificates can be checked at registration.
- **6.2** During the regatta any boat and its equipment may be subject to inspection at any time.
- **6.3** Classes are allowed to organize measurement of equipment inspection. This will be announced in the Sailing Instructions.

#### **7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Sailing Instructions are available on the event website from Friday September 6<sup>th</sup>. No hardcopy will be handed out at registration.







#### 8 VENUE

- **8.1** Addendum I shows the location of the regatta harbour.
- **8.2** Addendum II shows the approximate location of the racing areas. Races will be as close to the harbour entrance as possible

#### 9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be Olympic Trapezoid, or Upwind Downwind, or variations on these courses.

#### 10 TARGET TIMES

#### 11 PENALTY SYSTEM

**11.1** For the Yngling, J22, 49er, 49erFX, 29er, SB20, Star, Dart18 and F18 classes RRS 44.1 and Appendix P2.1 are changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

#### 12 SCORING

- **12.1** Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- **12.2** When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. When eleven or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.
- 12.3 Only for Contender: When nine races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race score excluding her two worst scores.

#### 13 [DP] SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall conspicuously display a flag or the three national sail letters with a minimum height of 200 mm of the country they represent.

#### 14 [DP] BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park and regatta harbour.

#### 15 [DP] HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Keel boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

#### 16 [DP] DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keel boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.







#### 17 [DP] RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in case of an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communications that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. VHF will only be used for safety communication, except for SB20 (see NoR 1.8).

#### 18 PRIZES

- **18.1** Helmsman and crew of the winning boat of the Dutch Championship acquire the title "Dutch Champion" and receive the accompanying medal(s) of the RNYU. The responsible person of the winning boat acquires the Blue Pennant of the RNYU.
- **18.2** Prizes will be given to every member of the crew of the first, second and third ranked boat in the event. The sailing instructions may describe more prizes.

#### 19 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### 20 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

#### 21 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 per event or the equivalent.

#### The following information is not part of the rules for the event.

CAMPERS/CARAVANS

Regulations in the Netherlands prohibit sleeping in tents, campers and caravans parked along public roads or in public car parks. On the designated area on the premises pf the Regatta Center Medemblik, sleeping in tents, caravans or camper is allowed provided a fee per night (incl. tourist tax) of

€ 19,00 per caravan/camper or

€ 15,00 per tent with more than 4 persons or

€ 10,00 per tent with 4 or less persons.

Free use of power and access card for free use of the regatta centre's sanitary facilities are included. The fee is payable at the Harbourmasters Office, next door to the Regatta Office.
