#### 6. MEASUREMENTS

Spot inspections will be undertaken at the discretion of the OA's nominated measurer.

## 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing Instructions shall be available by 11 July in electronic form only.

# 8. VENUE

- 8.1 Attachment 1 shows the location of the regatta harbour.
- 8.2 Attachment 2 shows the location of the racing area.

## 9. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed shall be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

#### 10. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1 For multihull classes and 29ers, RRS
  44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns
  Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn
  Penalty.
- 10.2 RRS Appendix P will apply for the following classes: Flying 11, Optimist Open, Optimist Intermediate and all Laser classes. Appendix P2.1 is amended so that when a boat is first penalised under rule P1.2 her penalty shall be a One-Turn Penalty (not a Two-Turn Penalty).

#### 11. SCORING

Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.
- When from five (5) to nine (9) races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- When nine (9) to twelve (12) races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her two (2) worst scores.
- When thirteen (13) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her three (3) worst scores.

# 12. SUPPORT BOATS

Coaches supporting athletes at the Championship shall register with the Organising Authority at the RQYS Sailing Office prior to the commencement of racing. Registration entitles coaches to a range of benefits including launching facilities. overnight berthina. refueling facilities, communication with athletes and access to race course outside of 50m of any competitor or mark between start signal and finish of last boat, except when asked to assist by the Race Committee.

- 12.2 Registration shall be completed by registering the support boat/s online, and then collecting a numbered and colored sticker from the Regatta Office upon arrival, prior to launching the support boat.
- 12.3 Support and spectator boats that do not register shall not be permitted to launch or retrieve from RQYS premises, or berth there overnight; the Organising Authority reserves the right to remove such vessels from their premises.
- 12.4 All support/coach boats must have the capability to communicate with the Race Committee on VHF 72 and 77 throughout the regatta.

#### 13. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

# 14. TELEVISION AND MEDIA

Attendance at a media/press conference each day may be required for the top three competitors in each class. Suitable notification will be given.

# 15. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participation in an event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authority and the sponsors of the event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for said event in which the competitor participated and in all material related to the said event without compensation.

# 16. PRIZES AND DIVISIONS

- 16.1 Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd in class/division for which 6 or more entries are received.
- 16.2 Single-handed classes shall award separate Male/Female podiums in each class.
- 16.3 In double-handed classes, podiums shall be awarded Overall with a separate 1st place awarded to the first opposite gendered skipper.
- 16.4 Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

# 17. DISCLAIMER OF ENTRY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
