PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. NZL 26 was sailing on starboard fetching mark 3 and BUL 27 was approaching the mark on port, on collision course
- 2. BUL 27 held her course with her kite at 10 o'clock
- 3. NZL 26 bore away keeping her kite low
- 4. NZL 26's kite collapsed and was wrapped around her foil
- 5. BUL 27 gybed to starboard and sailed on
- 6. NZL 26 recovered and finished the race in 28th place
- 7. There was no contact
- 8. The board of NZL 26 had a minor damage, no injury occurred and no kiteboard took a penalty

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. BUL 27 on port did not keep clear of NZL 26 on starboard breaking rule 10
- 3. The score of NZL 26 was not made significantly worse through no fault of their own by a tangle, damage or injury caused by the action of a kiteboard that was breaking a rule of part 2, therefore she is not entitled to redress

BUL 27 is DSQ in race 5 NZL 26 is not given redress
