PROCEDURAL MATTERS

The protestee (Boat 1452) did not turn up for the scheduled hearing. The protest was heard in his absence, in accordance with Rule 63.3(b).

FACTS FOUND

- 1. 1497 and 1452 were sailing on a reach after rounding Mark 1. The boats were on starboard tack and overlapped, 1452 was windward and 1497 was leeward.
- 2. The boats approached Mark 1A. When the leading boat entered the zone, the boats were overlapped, with 1497 on the inside and leeward.
- 3. Just before rounding the mark, 1452 bore down and contact occurred between the hulls of the boats.
- 4. There was no damage or injury.
- 5. Neither boat took any penalty turns.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. Boat 1452 being the windward boat failed to keep clear of 1497 on leeward, as required by Rule 11 and therefore broke Rule 11.
- 2. Boat 1452 also failed to give mark room to 1497 as required by Rule 18.2(b) and therefore also broke Rule 18.2 (b).
- 3. It was reasonably possible for Boat 1452 to avoid contact, which she failed to do so and therefore also broke Rule 14
