1. The protest met the requirements for arbitration under App T

FACTS FOUND

1. SGP2869 (windward) failed to keep clear of SGP1539 (leeward) when tacking resulting in SGP2869's stern making contact with SGP1539
2. There was no damage or injury
3. No boats took any penalty,
4. SGP2869 accepted that she broke RRS11 and RRS14.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

1. SGP2869 broke RRS11 and RRS14 and accepted a post race penalty in accordance with App T1 for Race 5

DECISION

1. The penalty imposed on SGP2869 shall be 30% of the score for DNF applied to race number 5, rounded to the nearest tenth of a point (0.05 to be rounded upward). The penalty shall be no worse than a score equal to DNF. The scores of other boats shall not be changed as a result of this penalty.
