FACTS FOUND

- 1. AUS 4220 was competing in the 2019 Australian Moth Championships.
- 2. Between Race 12 and 13 AUS 4220 was effecting repairs to their boat with the assistance of a RC vessel.
- 3. While the RC vessel was assisting AUS 4220 the RC vessel caused damage to the sail of AUS 4220.
- 4. The damage to the sail prevented AUS 4220 from competing in Races 13 and 14.
- 5. The circumstances surrounding the damage were confirmed by the RC vessel crew that their action contributed to the damage to the sail.
