Any cases of COVID 19 that should be detected during the event will be reported by the Organizing Committee to the competent health bodies in charge.

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. The IMCA Class Rules
- 1.3. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

### 2. ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to boats of the International Moth Class and Waszp Class.
- 3.2. **Maximum 80 moths are allowed. Maximum 80 Waszp are allowed.** Entries will be accepted by the first come – first served principle and payment is mandatory at the moment of entry. No entry can be completed without payment.
- 3.3. All boats have to comply with their Class Rules and all moths have a valid measurement certificates.
- 3.4. All competitors shall be members of their National Class Association or the International Class Association where there is no appropriate national class association.
- 3.5. The helmsperson named on the boat entry form shall be the same for all races.
- 3.6. Eligible competitors shall enter by completing the online entry process at: <http://fragliavela.sailti.com/en/default/races/calendar/year/2020/all/1>
- 3.7. Online entries will close on September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

### 4. FEES

- 4.1. Early entry fee, paid before the 1<sup>st</sup> of September: 150€.  
Late entry fee, paid after the 2<sup>nd</sup> of September: 180€
- 4.2. The entry fee must be paid by PayPal (Paypal commission is 5 € and it has to be paid by entrant). Payments cannot be made at the club by cash or credit card.

## 5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1. The scheduled time of the first warning signal on the 17<sup>th</sup> September 2020 is 13.00hrs.
- 5.2. There will be no warning signal made after 16.30hrs on 20<sup>th</sup> September 2020.
- 5.3. Schedule of social events will be posted on the Sailing Instructions.

## 6. MEASUREMENT

- 6.1. Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate for all equipment and sails at registration.
- 6.2. For moth only: Only a maximum of 2 sails, 2 masts, 2 front foils (vertical & horizontal) and 2 rear foils (vertical & horizontal) shall be used.
- 6.3. Equipment shall only be replaced with the permission of the Race Committee.
- 6.4. Boats may be subject to inspections at any time during the regatta.

## 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the 16<sup>th</sup> of September on the regatta website. NO printed copy will be provided by the OA.

## 8. VENUE

The event will be held at Fraglia Vela Malcesine. Via Gardesana 205, Frazione Navene - 37018 Malcesine, Italy.

## 9. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

## 10. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1. RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 10.2. Decisions of the Jury will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

## 11. SCORING

- 11.1. The Low Point System of Appendix „A“ will apply.
  - a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores.
  - b) When from 5 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
  - c) When 8 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.
- 11.2. Six boats are requested to constitute a class.

## 12. SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be registered with the Organizing Authority and shall display always the white flag with the red "S", given by the Club.

## 13. BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in the assigned places at the boat park.

## 14. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## 15. PRIZES

- 15.1. Prizes will be awarded to the top three competitors for each class with at least 6 participants. The first 6.9 Waszp will be awarded.
- 15.2. Additional prizes may be given at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

## 16. MEDIA RIGHTS, CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

- 16.1. By participating in Foiling Week 2020, competitors automatically grant the Organizing Authority and their sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.
- 16.2. Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment or positioning equipment as specified by the Organizing Authority.
- 16.3. The top three (3) competitors, as well as the individual race winners, may be required to attend a media press conference each day.
- 16.4. Competitors may be required to be interviewed during the regatta.

## 17. LIABILITY

The Fraglia Vela Malcesine, Foiling Week Association, the Race Committee, the Jury and all their officers, members and volunteers do not accept liability for loss of life or property, or personal injury or damage caused by or arising out of the regatta. Competitors take part in the regatta at their own risk.

The establishment of the notice of race and the sailing instructions in no way limits or reduces the complete and unlimited responsibilities of a competitor and their support people (coaches) being solely and entirely responsible for the management of a boat he is sailing.

All competitors shall maintain their boats in a safe and seaworthy condition.

A competitor shall be of good health and a competent sailor capable of racing in open water in all conditions including strong winds.

At-fault occurrences to other boats are the responsibility of the helmsman and the crew. Competitors are not covered by any liability insurance provided by the organizing authority and should provide their own coverage for personal goods and liability protection. The organizing authority recommends that competitors consult their own insurance carriers to assure they are covered at this event and regarding additional personal liability insurance coverage.

A competitor is recommended to have personal accident and health insurance that covers him while attending the regatta and while racing.

## 18. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €1.500.000 per incident or the equivalent. **Boat insurances shall be sent by email at [race@fragliavela.org](mailto:race@fragliavela.org) at the moment of registrations.**

## 19. CLEAN REGATTA

Competitors are required to avoid any single use plastic for food and beverage.

## 20. HOSPITALITY

- 20.1. Boats, Trailers and Cars will be hosted in the Yacht Club grounds from the 14<sup>th</sup> September to 21<sup>st</sup> of September 2020.

- 20.3. Campers are not allowed in the parking area of the Yacht Club (both during the day and the night).
