**ORGANIZING AUTHORITY**

**1. RULES**

- 1.1. The “Rules” as defined in Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) of the World Sailing 2021-2024
- 1.2. The World Sailing Offshore Special Regulations 2022. Category of the races is App.B
- 1.3. The World Sailing Regulation 20 (Advertising Code).
- 1.4. IRC Rules 2022, Parts A, B, C.
- 1.5. The Notice of Race, The Sailing Instructions and its amendments.
- 1.6. The official language of the event will be English.
- 1.7. If there is a conflict between the rules above, the Sailing Instructions and its amendments will be valid according to their date.
- 1.8. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

**2. ADVERTISING**

- 2.1. Yachts may display advertising in accordance with World Sailing Regulations 20, Advertising Code and TSF’s Advertising Regulations.
- 2.2. Yachts, which have the approval of their national authority, shall submit a copy of the approval to the Race Office on registration.
- 2.3. Yachts of the charter companies carrying companies’ names, signs and logos on their hulls and sails are acceptable.
- 2.4. The organizers may require competitors to display event sponsor’s advertising material. Stickers will be supplied at registration. These shall be affixed according to organizer’s instructions.

**3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY**

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all yachts measured under IRC measurement system with LOA between 7 to 27 m and with an inboard or outboard engine, and to yachts, which has no any valid 2022 IRC certificate and wish to race in Freshman Division.
- 3.2. The regatta is open to all sailors who comply with the World Sailing Eligibility Code.
- 3.3. No yacht shall be eligible to enter and compete in the races without her valid 2022 IRC rating certificate for IRC Classes and Freshman Class Declaration Form.
- 3.4. Eligible yachts may enter by completing the entry form and handing it together with the required fee, to MIYC office until, 16<sup>th</sup> September 2022, 1700hrs. (local)
- 3.5. All competitors except foreigners shall have a sportsman’s license valid for 2022.
- 3.6. Each skipper should submit a crew list with his or her “Race Entry Form”
- 3.7. There will be no upper crew limitation, but a minimum crew of 3 is required.
- 3.8. Every change of crew member shall be declared to the Race Office no later than two hours before the start time.

- 3.9. The organizing authority or the race committee may reject or cancel the entry of a yacht or exclude a competitor provided it does so before the start of the first race and states the reason for doing so (RRS 76.1).
- 3.10. All those registered are deemed to have accepted all the rules declared within the Notice of Race.
- 4. FEES**
- 4.1. The entry fee shall be € 150 per yacht.
- 4.2. All crew members and non-racing participants will pay a fee of € 30 per person for their participation to the social events.
- 4.3. A deposit of € 20 will be charged for the division signs and flags, which is refundable at the end of the regatta.
- 5. DIVISIONS & HANDICAP SYSTEM**
- 5.1. The yachts entered to the regatta will race in “IRC” and “Freshman” classes.
- 5.2. Division determination is made by the Organizing Committee in accordance with the TCC/TCF of the registered yachts in their divisions. It is definite and cannot be disputed.
- 5.3. The lowest corrected time (CT) with a boat will be declared the winner. Corrected time (CT) in the calculation of second round figures 50 and above shall be rounded to the upper value.
- 5.4. Flags to be used as a Division /Warning flags will be announced and posted on the official board by the Race Committee after all registrations complete.
- 5.5. Time on Time (TOT) system will be applied.
- 5.6. For IRC Divisions :Corrected Time (CT) = Elapsed Time (ET) x Time Correction Constant (TCC)
- 5.7. For Freshman Division(s) :Corrected Time (CT) = Elapsed Time (ET) x Time Correction Factor (TCF)
- 5.8. The TCF of a boat in the Freshman class(es) is calculated as follows:
- 5.9.  $TCF = (0,2424 \times VR) / (1 + 0,0567 \times VR)$  The Rating value  $R = 2.65 \times LOA$  (m) and is subject to Age Reduction.
- 5.10. Spinnaker (symmetric/asymmetrical) penalty for Freshman Class(es) is +10% of the Age Reduced Rating.
- 5.11. Age Reductions to be applied to the Freshman Class boats shall be as follows;

- 6. SCHEDULE**
- 6.1. Registration: Until 16<sup>th</sup>September, 1700hrs. (local)
- 6.2. Regatta Documents: 16<sup>th</sup>September, 1900hrs. (local) at MIYC
- 6.3. Opening Ceremony : 16<sup>th</sup>September, 2000hrs. (local) at MIYC
- 6.4. Skipper Briefing: 17<sup>th</sup>September, 1000hrs. (local) at MIYC
- 6.5. For all races; First warning signal at 1200hrs. (local)
- 6.6. Saturday, 17<sup>th</sup>, Race 1.
- 6.7. Sunday, 18<sup>th</sup> Race 2 & Race 3 after the end of Race #2
- 6.8. Monday, 19<sup>th</sup> Race 4: Monday.
- 6.9. Closing & Prize Giving Ceremony: T.B.A.
- 6.10. On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be given after 1430 hrs. If the first division(s) have their starting signal before 1430 then the other divisions may be given a starting signal after 1430.
- 7. MEASUREMENT & CONTROL**
- 7.1. Each yacht shall provide a valid 2022 IRC certificate and Freshman measurement declaration form.
- 7.2. The yachts may be measured before or after any race even without a need for protest.
- 8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**
- 8.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and may also be available earlier at [www.miycc.org](http://www.miycc.org)
- 9. VENUE**
- 9.1. The races will be in the inner and outer harbors of Marmaris Bay.
- 10. COURSES and TIME LIMITS**
- 10.1. Courses & Time limits will be as described in the Sailing Instructions and the course charts.
- 10.2. The change of the courses, starting or finishing lines is at the discretion of the Race Committee. This is not be grounds for a request for redress.
- 11. NUMBER OF RACES & SCORING**
- 11.1. Four (4) inshore and/or coastal races and are scheduled for the event.

- 11.2. At least one (1) races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 11.3. A boat's score will be the total of her race scores. No race is discardable.
- 11.4. The Low Point Scoring System of RRS A4 will be applied.
- 11.5. In case of tie RRS A8 will be applied.

**12. BERTHING**

- 12.1. All yachts will be moored in Netsel Marina free of charge, between 17-19 September 2022.
- 12.2. Marmaris Netsel Marina must be supplied with the following documents on arrival of the boats:
  - 12.2.(a). Port Registration deed or Custom Boat Registration Certificate or Certificate of tonnage.
  - 12.2.(b). Permit Range (Transit Log)
  - 12.2.(c). Insurance Policy

**13. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS**

- 13.1. Yachts shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the Race Committee.
- 13.2. Netsel Marina has hauling / launching and complete maintenance and repair facilities

**14. DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS**

- 14.1. Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around yachts between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.

**15. RADIO COMMUNICATION**

- 15.1. It is mandatory to have a VHF marine radio and to keep it open during the races. All yachts should listen to VHF Channel 71
- 15.2. Except in an emergency, a yacht shall neither make radio transmissions nor receive radio communications not available to all other yachts. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
- 15.3. Failure to make a broadcast or to time it accurately will not be grounds for a request for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a). Race Committee's announcements are not considered as outside help.

**16. PRIZES**

- 16.1. At the end of the regatta, first three best scoring yachts (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>) will be awarded for each division.
- 16.2. Special Prize: Additional prizes may be awarded according to the Organizing Authority's decisions.

**17. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

- 17.1. The sailing races can be dangerous. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race – "The responsibility for boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."
- 17.2. The Marmaris International Yacht Club, The Offshore Yachting Club of Rhodes, The Race&Protest Committee and all parties involved in the regatta organization will not accept any liability for damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**18. INSURANCE**

- 18.1. Each participating boat and the crew must be insured with sufficient and valid insurance cover to meet all or any claims and third party coverage.

**19. PRESS CENTER**

- 19.1. Journalists covering the series are requested to contact the secretariat of MIYC.

**20. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS**

- 20.1. In participating, a competitor automatically grants to the Organizing Authority and the sponsors, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of competition in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said Event without compensation.
