- 1. AUS 1319 was represented by Aaron Linton.
- 2. AUS 82 was represented by Billy Sykes.
- 3. Rod Warren (helm of 1319) attended the hearing as a witness for 1319.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. The wind was 8-10kts
- 2. At Mark 2, 1319 was clear ahead of 82.
- 3. Both boats were on starboard tack.
- 4. During the hoist of 82's spinnaker her pole created a leeward overlap with 1319.
- 5. The helmsman of 1319 thought a collision was imminent.
- 5. 1319 altered course to windward to avoid a potential contact between her hull and 82's spinnaker pole.
- 6. 82 subsequently bore away and gybed.
- 7. There was no contact.
