PROCEDURAL MATTERS

1. NED 20 presented video evidence.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Wind 12-15 knots, small choppy waves.
- 2. At the start of race 3, FRA 18 and NED 20 were sailing upwind on starboard tack with FRA 18 20m clear ahead and 15m to leeward of NED 20.
- 2 seconds after the start, FRA 18 fell off her foil. The competitor fell into the water and the kite rose to the 12 o'clock position.
- 4. NED 20 immediately attempted to raise her kite.
- 5. 4 to 5 seconds after FRA 18 fell off her foil, contact occurred between NED 20's left tip of her kite and FRA 18's right tip and leading edge of her kite.
- 6. Then FRA 18's kite collapsed and fell into the water.
- 7. There was no tangle, injury or damage.
- 8. Neither kiteboard took a penalty turn.
- 9. FRA 18 did not recover and retired from the race.
- 10. NED 20 finished the race.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 14, F.22.2, 44.1, 62.1 and 64.2(a)

- 1. While recovering, FRA 18 failed to keep clear of NED 20 who was not recovering, and broke RRS F2.22.2.
- 2. FRA 18 did not avoid contact when it was reasonably possible, and broke RRS 14.
- 3. It was not reasonably possible for NED 20, the right-of-way boat, to avoid contact with FRA 18 when it was clear that FRA 18 was not keeping clear. NED 20 did not break RRS 14.
- 4. Since RRS 44.1(b) did not apply, FRA 18 took an applicable penalty by retiring.
- 5. FRA18's score in race 3 was made significantly worse through her own fault. Therefore, the requirements for redress in RRS 62.1 are not met.
