7. Description Of Incident

Whilst sailing on a run approximately 60 to 70 metres from the final downwind mark; I was alleged by the Jury boat to have infringed Rule 42. I immediately responded to the yellow flag by performing a 360 degree turn in a clockwise direction and sailed for one or two boat lengths whilst trying to avert capsize. The eventual 9th placed boat (which at the time of alleged infringement was approximately 2 boat lengths behind me and approximately 3 boat lengths from my initial Starboard side) said: (verbatim) "I don't want to take a place from you but don't you need to do 2 turns?" I responded: (verbatim) "Yes you're right, thanks". I immediately did a second clockwise 360 degree turn and continued to finish the race. I correctly completed a 720 degree turn in the time it took to perform initial turn, avert capsize , have the above conversation then prepare for and execute second turn. Probably within 6 boat lengths. The 9th placed boat said immediately after the race words to the effect of sorry to remind you about the turn and I responded to thank him, I was sure rule 42 requires 2 turns. I correctly performed a 720 degree turn to exonerate myself. I should not be disqualified and demand reinstatement. I shall contact the 9th placed sailor to ask for him to corroborate the above statement.
