

Sailing Instruction Amendment 1:

Delete SI 10.1 & 10.2 and replace with new SI 10

10. Marks 1 ,2 and 3 will be large, inflatable, cylindrical yellow buoys. Mark 1a will be a large yellow Dumpy buoy. The Start mark for gate starts will be a red dumpy buoy.

Delete SI12.2 and replace with new SI 12.2

12.2 For a line start, the starting line is between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Committee boat at the starboard end and a red and white striped flag-pole displaying an orange flag on a Race Committee vessel at the port end.

Delete SI13.1,13.2 &1.3 and replace with new SI13.

13.To change the next leg of the course, the race committee will move the original mark or the finishing line to a new position. Minor movements of a mark position (up to 150 metres or 5 degrees) may be made without signalling the change.

B10 Penalties final sentence is changed to

If the race is abandoned because of a boat's interference with the Pathfinder, Gate Launch or Guard Launch, her number will be displayed on the race committee signal boat before the next warning signal. If the race is re-started or re-sailed, she shall not sail in it. If she does so, her disqualification shall not be excluded in calculating her series score. This changes RRS 63.1 and A5
