- 2. PAK35 was on port tack.
- 3. Both PAK21 and PAK35 were on a converging course.
- 4. PAK21 hailed starboard.
- 5. PAK35 failed to respond.
- 6. PAK21 bore down behind PAK21's transom to avod contact with PAK35
- 7. There was no contact and no injury
- 8. If PAK 21 had not altered course PAK21 will hit PAK35 on the rear starboard quarter or rudder.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY
