PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

Facts about validity:

- 1. CAN 60 lodged a request for redress at 22:05, when he had access to the internet.
- 2. Heat 11 D finished at 15:55.
- 3. There was a discussion immediately after the finish of Heat D on the dock.
- 4. It is not clear weather CAN 60 informed the Race Committee orally after finishing in race 11 D.
- 5. Heat 11 C started at 16:05.

Facts Found:

- 1. CAN 60 took a Two-Turns Penalty just before the finishing line.
- 2. CAN 60 finished race 11 D and was scored by the race committee in her finishing place.
- 3. CAN 60 was DSQ by an umpire and he was scored accordingly by the race committee.
- 4. The race committee was instructed by the umpires to continue racing without delay.
