## FACTS FOUND

- 1. In Race 1, the wind was light and sea flat.
- 2. Mark 1 was set at 240 degrees. During the race, the wind oscillated between 220 degrees and 255 degrees.
- 3. On the first leg, the fleet was sailing towards mark 1 on a reaching course.
- 4. After rounding mark 1, the fleet was on a beat and later on a reach to the next mark.
- 5. MAS 1038, MAS 555, and MAS 4911 finished the race.
