PROCEDURAL MATTERS

Joerg Esdorn, Thomas Allard and Paul Zupan appeared via Zoom conference call.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. There was approximately two knots of adverse current at the windward mark.
- 2. Kincsem was close hauled fetching the first windward mark.
- 3. Yellowfin was to leeward of Kincsem as Kincsem was trying to round the mark.
- 4. Yellowfin was not making the mark and tacked to pass astern of Kincsem.
- 5. Kincsem attempted to avoid a collision by altering to windward.
- 6. Yellowfin's bow collided with Kincsem in the aft port quarter, about a meter forward of the stern.
- 7. The contact caused some splintered gel coat and crushed fiberglass. Additionally, the port side push pit was dislodged and bent.
- 8. Yellowfin rounded the mark and executed two turns as a penalty.
- 9. Yellowfin retired from race three subsequent to the race.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: 10 14

- 1. Yellowfin on port failed to keep clear of Kincsem on starboard, and broke RRS 10
- 2. Yellowfin did not avoid contact when it was reasonably possible, and broke RRS 14.
- 3. It was not reasonably possible for Kincsem, the right-of-way boat to avoid contact with Yellowfin when it was clear that Yellowfin was not keeping clear. Kincsem did not break RRS 14.

DECISION

Yellowfin retired from race 3 and cannot be penalized further.
