EXPECTED MARINE FORECAST

Marine Synopsis - In the wake of the frontal passage, cool fair weather moves in as high pressure builds in from the west. Cold air cloud continues to be advected into the area from the north which will keep skies cloudy during the morning but sunshine may peak through later today.

Today - Winds northeasterly 12 to 18 knots, veering easterly by evening... Seas inside the reef 1 to 3 ft... Outside the reef 6 to 9 ft, decreasing during the morning...
