PROCEDURAL MATTERS

HKG300 did not come to the hearing, the hearing proceeded in accordance with RRS 63.3(b).

FACTS FOUND

- 1. HKG300 was sailing on a beat to windward towards the finish line.
- 2. Jury Boat (inflatable Rib) was on-the-water observing per Appendix P.
- 3. HKG300 was on a converging course with Jury Boat, who was on a downwind heading.
- 4. Jury Boat tried to avoid contact by turning to starboard.
- 5. However, HKG300 collided with Jury Boat's port sponson.
- 6. The collision allowed at least 2 boats to pass HKG300.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

HKG300's place in race 9 was made significantly worse through no fault of her own by an improper action or omission of the protest committee. Therefore, the requirements for redress in RRS 62.1(a) are met.
