Parking

Where possible please share lifts to and from the venue as parking is limited and we are aiming for the event to be as sustainable as possible.

If you need to travel by vehicle, then please use Fort Cumberland Car park. This is free and will be marshalled to maximise capacity but get there early to ensure a space! This car park is roughly a 5 minute walk to the event site.

There is parking along the seafront but this will be busy and you will need to pay for a space.



Site access

Access to the site will be from 15th September. Please see the site plan below showing where the storage tent will be.



When dropping off equipment (and collecting equipment at the end of the event) please use the old swimming pool car park (indicated below). Once you have unloaded your equipment please move your car to the Fort Cumberland car park as there are limited spaces here.
