CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: SI 1.3.1; Addendum SB2.3; 62 IOD 6's score in race 7 was made significantly worse, through no fault of her own, because of physical damage not falling within RRS 62.1 (b) which was due to defective supplied equipment and which a reasonably competent crew would not have been able to avoid or promptly repair.

DECISION

Redress is given to IOD 6. IOD 6 is to be scored in race 7 points equal to 4th. No other boat's score shall change.
