### PROCEDURAL MATTERS **Original Hearing**

- 1. Hearing held under RRS N1.4 (b) with a panel of three members.
- 2. The hearing started at 17:05.
- 3. Representative of SUI, Nik was the crew and the representative of ARG, Martin was the crew.

#### Consideration of the Reopening

- 1. The decision of Case 22 was announced to both parties at 1800h.
- 2. ARG requested for a full panel and to reopen Case 22, submitted at 1836h as Case 30.
- 3. The reconsideration to reopen started at 1840h and ended at 1852h, with a full panel of five members. The additional two members were Ken (IJ - POR) and Line (IJ, DEN).
- 4. ARG claims that according to the tracking evidence by TracTrac, there was no overlap between SUI and ARG.

## **FACTS FOUND Original Hearing**

- 1. The wind speed was 6 knots and the sea-state was flat.
- 2. SUI, JPN and ARG were sailing downwind towards Mark 4P on converging courses.
- 3. All three boats were overlapped when the three boats entered the zone with SUI and JPN on starboard tack, ARG on
- 4. ARG outside, SUI in the middle and JPN inside, the gap between each boat was 1.5 BL apart.
- 5. JPN gybed to port when her bow was abeam with the mark.
- 6. JPN rounded the mark with less than half boat-width from the mark.
- 7. ARG luffed towards JPN narrowing the gap between the two boats to 50cm.
- 8. SUI luffed sharply to pass astern of ARG and rounded the mark clear astern of ARG.
- 9. The next leg of the course after Mark 4P was a reach to the finishing line.
- 10. There was no contact and neither boats took a penalty.

### **CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY**

Rules: RRS 18.2(b) and 66, SI 17.1

### **Original Hearing**

1. ARG, outside overlapped at the zone, failed to give SUI mark-room, and broke RRS 18.2(b).

# **Consideration of the Reopening**

- 1. SI 17.1 does not allow a boat to use information from the tracking system as evidence.
- 2. The Jury did not make a significant error in the original hearing. Therefore, the requirements in RRS 66.1 for reopening the hearing are not met.
