The following is a request for authorization on behalf of the hosting club YCBE (Yacht Club Bracciano Est), for temporary changing the ILCA Class rules 4(e)ii and 7(a), during the upcoming ILCA Master National Regatta, to be raced on May 21-22, 2022 at the YCBE, in Trevignano Romano (Roma), Italy.

If so authorized, the amended rules will read as follows:

4(e) ii -- "After written approval from the Race Committee, a competitor may use a sail with numbers that are different to the sail number allocated to the hull."

7(a) -- "The boat shall be raced with only one person aboard."

The authorization, if granted, will be duly posted on the official Notice Board of the event (as per RRS 87) and be effective solely during the event mentioned above.
