### **PROCEDURAL MATTERS**

Hearing under N1.4 with three jury members.

### **FACTS FOUND**

- 1. FRA and CHI were approaching mark 1 on opposite tacks, FRA on starboard.
- 2. CHI crossed in front of FRA, then tacked and established a windward overlap to FRA.
- 3. When CHI completed her tack, she was 1,5 boat length from the mark.
- 4. CHI was half a boat length ahead of FRA.
- 5. The distance between FRA and CHI was one boatwidth.
- 6. After completing the tack, CHI was sailing a lower angle than FRA and the distance between the boats was decreasing.
- 7. FRA bore away to avoid contact with CHI.
- 8. FRA touched the mark.
- 9. Both boats passed the mark.
- 10. FRA took a penalty turn.

# **CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY**

Rules: 11, 18.3, 31

- 1. CHI to windward failed to keep clear of FRA to leeward and broke RRS 11.
- 2. After CHI passed head to wind from port to starboard tack inside the zone and was then fetching the mark, she failed to give mark-room to FRA who was overlapped inside her. CHI broke RRS 18.3.
- 3. Since FRA broke RRS 31 while she was sailing within the mark-room to which she was entitled, she is exonerated under RRS 43.1(b) for this breach.

CHI is DSQ from Race 8.
