FACTS FOUND

- 1. 2022 Typhoon Series Race 5 course for Classes IRC C, HKPN A and J80 was signalled as Course #24.
- 2. The sailing instructions described Course #24 as follows:

Start - Club Mark - Gate - Basalt (s) - Basalt Mark (p) - Finish at Table

- 3. Note 1 of *Notes for the Race 5 Courses* mentioned the following pertinent information regarding the 'Gate'.
- (1) The Gate will be located in the vicinity of 22°22.0' N, 114°25.0' E (approximately 1.5 NM east of Conic Island). The Gate will be formed by two orange buoys. All boats must pass between the two buoys. On passing through the Gate on Course No. 24, boats shall round the port buoy before proceeding to the next mark.
- 4. The following boats passed through the gate and proceeded to round the starboard buoy to starboard.

HKPN - A - HKG 1341 - Jibulai J80 - HKG 2258 - Jelik 7 - Hebe Dragons IRC - C - HKG 1045 - Moll J80 - HKG 2252 - Footloose

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 28.1, A5.1

- 1. The Course Description was made up of a table and notes, which required boats sailing Course #24, on passing through the gate, to round the port-end buoy of the gate before proceeding to the next mark.
- 2. Any boat which did not round the port end buoy failed to sail the course as required by RRS28.1.
