PROCEDURAL MATTERS

- 1. JPN 108236 was represented by Haku Marsden
- 2. The Organizing Authority did not come to the hearing. The hearing proceeded in accordance with RRS 63.3(b).
- 3. Mike Marsden, father of JPN 108236 represented the sailor during the hearing.
- 4. Kentaro Tanaka, coach of JPN 108236 attended the hearing as an observer.
- 5. Based on the information in the written request, the International Jury proceeded with Case No. 1 as a request of redress as permitted by RRS 64.1(c).

FACTS FOUND

- 1. The O'pen Skiff U15 fleet raced 4 races on the 17th of July 2023.
- 2. JPN 108236's boat was provided by the official supplier of the boats for the event (Tahe Outdoors France).
- 3. JPN 108236 realized that his boat was taking in water after the end of race 1. JPN 108236 approached his coach rib and drained water between races.
- 4. JPN 108236 came back ashore at 17:00.
- 5. Afterwards, JPN 108236's boat was inspected by the provider representative approximately around 18:00. The boat had a pin hole at the bottom of the mast slot and the silicon was missing at the bow section of the hull.
- 6. After coming back ashore, JPN 108236 de-rigged the boat and went for dinner.
- 7. JPN 108236 waited and contacted his club in Japan in order to use their expertise on how to proceed with the hearing. Due to a difference in the time zone they managed to contact the club approximately at 23:30.
- 8. The protest time limit for the U15 fleet on the 17th of July 2023 was at 19:05.
- 9. JPN 108236 lodged a request for redress at 23:54 on the 17th of July 2023.

JPN 108236 failed to deliver the request for redress as reasonably possible after learning of the reasons for making it, as required by RRS 62.2.
