EXPECTED MARINE FORECAST

Marine Synopsis - Another rapidly deepening low will sweep a cold front across us later today with patchy rain and scattered showers. Moderate winds soon increase strong before gales develop tonight into Sunday...

Today - Winds southwesterly 10 to 15 knots, rapidly increasing 20 to 30 knots during the morning, with gusts to 45 knots from afternoon, veering westerly towards evening... Isolated showers becoming scattered showers and patchy rain with the chance of thunder and fair to very poor visibility... Seas inside the reef 2 to 4 ft...
