EXPECTED MARINE FORECAST

Marine Synopsis - The mature low to our northeast will gradually lift farther away, however there are still a few more troughs expected to pass through our region until the last of the series crosses over during Saturday. The troughs bring isolated showers and blustery west winds that veer with each trough passage as they ease. Higher pressure then pushes in from the northwest causing rough seas to abate.

Today - Winds west-northwesterly 16 to 22 knots... Isolated to occasionally scattered showers with mainly fair visibility... Seas inside the reef 2 to 4 ft..
