PROCEDURAL MATTERS

- 1. Tina and Seven (Jury Secretaries) and Xiaolong Xu (Jury member) attended the hearing as observers.
- 2. Zhang Xiguang attended the hearing as interpreter for CHN.
- 3. Arthit Mikhail Romanyk (THA) appeared as a witness for BRN.
- 4. Katsumi Shibanuma (Jury member) gave evidence during the hearing.
- 5. BRN was represented by Abdulla Mohamed Ageel Janahi and CHN by Yinsheng Cui.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. The wind was 10 to 12 knots and the sea was choppy.
- 2. Around 30 seconds before the starting signal, BRN and CHN were approximately 1 boat length below the starting line.
- 3. The boats were on starboard tack and overlapped, with CHN around half a boat length to leeward of BRN and around half a boat length ahead of her.
- 4. CHN luffed gradually and passed head to wind to port tack.
- 5. Before CHN was on a close hauled course, she again luffed and passed head to wind back to starboard tack and bore away to a close hauled course.
- 6. BRN held her course and was then clear astern of CHN.
- 7. BRN bore away astern of CHN, gybed and sailed towards the starting line on port tack.
- 8. There was no contact.
- 9. Neither boat took a penalty.

- 1. When acquiring right of way through her own actions, CHN initially gave BRN room to keep clear and complied with RRS 15
- 2. No rules were broken.
